



Fishing Information

We have 3 lakes at Yaxham Waters Holiday Park: Lakeside Lake, Priors Field Lake, and Meadow Field Lake. All lakes contain the following coarse freshwater fish: Carp, Rudd, Tench, and Golden Tench. Our nearest tackle shop is Myhills (2 miles away) in Dereham (www.myhillspetandgarden.co.uk).

Where to Fish:

- Lakeside Lake – you can fish from the far-side of the lake or from the island.
- Priors Field Lake – you can fish anywhere around this lake.
- Meadow Field Lake – you can fish along the edge opposite the lodges.

If you are staying in a lodge directly on the water's edge (LS1-LS7B, MF6-MF9) you may fish in front of the lodge which you are occupying as well as the locations listed above.

Fishing Licences:

Fishing is free of charge to anyone staying on our holiday park; however, fishing licences must be purchased before commencing fishing.

- Children under the age of 13 do not need a fishing licence.
- Children aged 13 to 16 require a free junior fishing licence.
- Anyone aged 17+ must purchase the correct fishing licence.

The Environment Agency perform random checks for fishing licences. You can get a fine of up to £2,500 (and your fishing equipment can be seized) if you are fishing and cannot show a valid rod fishing licence when asked.

Our Park Rules:

- A maximum of 2 fishing rods per person.
- Fishing rods are not to be left unattended.
- Fishing alarms are not permitted.
- Children under 16 must always be accompanied by an adult.
- Only barbless hooks are allowed.
- Landing nets and unhooking mats must be used.
- When weighing fish, use a weigh sling or landing net.
- Keep nets can be used.
- All fish must be returned to the lake.
- Fishing must stop at midnight and can resume from 6am.
- Other guests should not be disturbed by lights or equipment.
- All rubbish must be put in the bins provided around the park.

Safety and First Aid:

Lifebuoy are situated around the lakes and First Aid kits can be found in the SOS cabinets around the park. Please familiarise yourself with their locations prior to fishing.
